The Ego and the Mechanisms of Defense by Anna Freud

Freud said repression, the unconscious suppression of impulses that could be problematic if they were acted upon, was the principle defense mechanism. She also detailed a number of other defense mechanisms, including denial, projection, and displacement.

Anna Freud, Founder of Child Psychoanalysis

Anna Freud (3 December 1895 - 9 October 1982) was an Austrian-British psychoanalyst. She was born in Vienna, the sixth and youngest child of Sigmund Freud and Martha Bernays.She followed the path of her father and contributed to the field of psychoanalysis.Alongside Melanie Klein, she may be considered the founder of psychoanalytic child psychology.

Sigmund Freud describes how the Ego uses a range of mechanisms to handle the conflict between the Id, the Ego and the Super ego. His daughter Anna introduced the principle of inner mechanisms that defend the ego in her 1936 book 'The Ego and the Mechanisms of Defense'.

Defense Mechanisms - Changing minds

Throughout her life Anna Freud defended the need to care for and address a child's early relationships as an essential mechanism for proper development. Her work with children who had been abandoned or severely neglected, for example, laid the foundation for multiple subsequent lines of research.

Anna Freud and her work after Sigmund Freud

Anna Freud called this defense mechanism regression, suggesting that people act out behaviors from the stage of psychosexual development in which they are fixated. For example, an individual fixated at an earlier developmental stage might cry or sulk upon hearing unpleasant news.
